Elaine Cohalan was raised on a dairy and beef farm in Kilmichael, Co. Cork surrounded by green fields and lots of siblings. Her family taught her to value locally sourced foods and the worth of the Irish producer. Though Elaine spent years working in education, marketing and business, she was ultimately drawn back to food and the booming Irish produce scene.

Alongside her partner Jenny Synnott, Elaine set up The Dublin Cookie Company in March 2014. After a couple of years travelling around the country to farmers markets' and festivals, they launched their cookie dough through Food Academy in twenty SuperValu supermarkets in late 2015.

In March 2016, to mark their 2nd birthday, The Dublin Cookie Company opened Ireland's first cookie shop in The Liberties, Dublin 8. Here, they hand craft their signature cookies and cookie dough and dream up new innovative flavours for the counter. They also sell a range of flavoured milks, speciality teas and coffees. Elaine and Jenny have lots of plans for the future of their company, including supplying more supermarkets in Ireland and exporting to the UK and the USA. They also intend to open more cookie shops both in Ireland and internationally.
