Sound Bounce combines the power of noise cancelling electronics with the competitive cost of foam hearing protection which has been independently verified to absorb sound up to 8 times more effectively than foam.

At Restored Hearing, Rhona and her team aim to change the way the world hears by removing the risk of avoidable hearing damage. The company is completely community focused. Restored Hearing reach out to the community and provide a safe place where people can discuss how tinnitus and hearing loss makes them feel. Those feelings need to be treated with compassion, open-mindedness, honesty and most of all kindness.
